Dear Friends,

Influencers have been around as long as people have been. From the earliest monarchies there have been people behind the throne shaping the way the king or queen made decisions. In my lifetime it has been a forgone conclusion that those big companies with products to sell would hire a famous athlete or the like to influence us to shop a particular brand. This is why every Superbowl champion says they are going to Disney World and why Shaquille O'Neill makes far more money as an influencer than he ever did as an NBA basketball player.



Now that so many people are connected to digital devices the number of influencers has skyrocketed. Influencers are all over social media these days — when we see a person we admire sharing their favorite products, we find ourselves embracing their interests, their hopes and sometimes their lifestyles.

This isn't really a new idea, though.

Jesus called us to use our influence to be his ambassadors, to be his light in a dark world. Jesus understood that people are watching us and can be inspired by us to change the world.

As Easter people we are invited into the role of influencers – those who have something special they cannot wait for others to hear, see, and encounter. It begins in the Bethlehem manger where God breaks into human history, and continues through the moment when we declare in worship Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!! Think about it.

The disciple Andrew is often referred to as the Bringer because he wanted others to experience the grace and mercy he found so readily in Christ's presence. The Samaritan woman at the well shared her encounter with Jesus with all those in her community because she couldn't contain her excitement and wanted others to experience Jesus too. Joseph of Arimethea, the wealthy man who loaned Jesus his tomb, didn't just make his offer out of thin air. He was influenced by the stories he heard of Jesus preaching and teaching. The women who went to the tomb that first Easter couldn't wait to tell their friends what they encountered – from an empty tomb to the gardener telling them Jesus would meet them in Galilee.

You and I are the people of Good Shepherd today because this pattern of influencers has shared the good news – the gospel – of Jesus' love and grace with generation after generation. What will we do with this message of hope, living water, forgiveness, and resurrection? Will we lock it away? Or will you and I take up the mantle and carry the message into our world?

Join us in worship this Easter season as we consider together all the ways we can proclaim to the world around us Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!!


